New Jersey Sunshine Law - Read by Board President Redd

The New Jersey Public Meetings Law was enacted to ensure the right to the public to have advanced notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interest is discussed or acted on.

On the rules of this act, the Trenton Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting by publicizing the date, time and place, therefore posted in the Central Services Building, 108 North Clinton Avenue, City Clerk's Office, City Hall and the Times. Anyone whose name is on the mailing list should receive a notice.

Formal action will take place at this meeting.

PRESENTATIONS TO THE BOARD

Ms. Feria and Ms. Howard presented on the 2016-2017 Budget for the Public Hearing (handout attached). The Board had questions and comments as follows:

- Reasons for additions in confidential employee positions
- Challenges faced and adjustments made in reaching a balanced budget
- Handling the effects of a difference in amounts budgeted versus amounts expensed
- Addressing the disparity between State estimates versus actual charter school enrollment counts
- Appreciation for reducing the shortfall and for incorporating adjustments from the County
- Eliminating the effects of long term rising costs
- · Difference between a deficit and a shortfall
- Specific strategies for keeping students in District
- Addressing the gap in transportation aid
- Advocating for a fair percentage of funding for special ed students

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Ms. Betty Glenn, President of the Trenton Paraprofessionals Association, spoke about the negative effects of staff reductions in her unit. She stated there is not an adequate level of personnel in the schools to provide services to students. She asked the Board

to stand with the unions in advocating to the State for our students, and she asked them to vote with their heart and say No to the budget.

Ms. Tiffani Finley, Speech Therapist, expressed her concerns with the plan to privatize the related services positions of Speech/Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Physical Therapists. She asked the Board to vote No on this proposal, or to defer their vote until complete information is provided in order to make an educated decision. She felt it will be impossible for a private agency to provide the same quality of related services currently being provided by employees in the 16 positions slated for elimination.

Mr. Ben Kenion, Occupational Therapist, also discussed the proposed cuts to the Child Study Teams. He stated there will be negative repercussions from this action, including increased costs and lack of connection with the community.

Mr. Billie Hayes, Community Member, felt his right to speak was interfered with at the last Board Meeting. He also stated that the Comprehensive Equity Plan (Finance Item M) was not signed, nor was there a community stakeholder indicated as participating in the development of the Plan. Mr. Hayes expressed concern about the proposed closing of Stokes School. He also felt that the Budget is discriminatory based on race and special needs.

Ms. Naomi Johnson-Lafleur, President of the Trenton Education Association, asked the Board to reject the Budget, agreeing with Mr. Hayes. She stated it targets the most needy student population. She felt that Administration did not work collaboratively with the unions on this year's Budget. Ms. Johnson-Lafleur said that the quality of service is decreased by privatization. She also spoke about the years of experience of the Child Study Team members.

TCHS Principal Hope Grant, President of the Trenton Administrators and Supervisors Association, agreed with Ms. Glenn about the quality of outsourcing. She also stated that the State has a plan to dismantle public schools, partly through the continuing expansion of charter schools. She said that charter schools do not have to follow the same requirements as public schools, and they do not educate the same population.

Ms. Janice Williams, Grievance Chair for TEA, stated that the Board has already reviewed the Budget through an ad hoc committee. She also expressed concern about staffing increases in Human Resources despite layoffs elsewhere in the District. Ms. Williams stated that the Mayor promised the President of every bargaining unit last year that they would be involved in the Budget process.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REMARKS

Superintendent Feria agreed that charter schools do not accept the same students as public schools. She said this is a challenge faced by urban districts across the country. She also stated that it was a challenge to try and close a \$5.9 million shortfall without

impacting lives. She said that Administration tried to do its best with the numbers that were given.

BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Gomez Salazar said he was at a loss for words in light of some of the public comments, and he asked if the Budget was discriminatory. Ms. Feria replied no. Mr. Gomez Salazar also asked if Administration had met with the Union Leadership. Ms. Feria stated they met and asked the unions for suggestions, which was met with the response that the unions have nothing left to give. She stated that if she felt the Budget was discriminatory, she would not have engaged in it. She said there were cuts across many unions, both in this year and in past years.

Mr. Gomez Salazar took exception to the contention that the Budget is discriminatory, and he said he will not be intimidated into voting no. He said he will vote for what needs to be done. He also expressed concern that the positive things happening in the District are not publicized enough, but negative stories about public disagreement on the Budget will be in the newspaper.

Dr. Rosenbaum said she would vote no on the Budget if she thought it would do any good, but it will not. She stressed the importance of voting for candidates who are in favor of education and for everyone to band together in this effort.

Mr. Truehart asked for the statutory timeframe for voting on the Budget. Ms. Howard responded that once the Budget is approved, Human Resources personnel meet with all affected parties regarding job status. Letters must go out by May 15 informing all of their job status for the coming year. This is a legal requirement.

WHEREAS, the Trenton Public School District Board of Education is committed to dedicating our resources and attention to reducing chronic absenteeism rates, with a focus starting as early as kindergarten; and,

WHEREAS, chronic absence – missing 10 percent or more of school for any reason including excused and unexcused absences, or just two or three days a month – is a proven predictor of academic trouble and dropout rates; and

WHERAS, good attendance is essential to student achievement and graduation for Trenton Public School District students; and

WHEREAS, improving attendance and reducing chronic absence takes commitment, collaboration, and tailored approaches to particular challenges and strengths in each community; and

WHEREAS, chronic absence may cause lower third-grade reading proficiency, course failure and eventual dropout, and weaken our communities and our local economy; and

WHEREAS, chronic absence may exacerbate the achievement gap that separates low-income students from their peers, since students from low-income families are both more likely to be chronically absent and more likely to be affected academically by missing school; and

WHEREAS, schools and community partners can reach out more frequently to absent students to determine why they are missing school and what would help them attend more regularly. We can encourage broad community engagement and sustained civic action to help parents get their children to school every day; and

WHEREAS, all Trenton Public School students – even those who show up regularly – are affected by chronic absence because teachers must spend time reviewing for students who missed lessons; and

WHEREAS, chronic absence can be significantly reduced when Trenton schools, parents and communities work together to monitor and promote good attendance and address hurdles that keep children from getting to school; and

RESOLVED, that the Trenton Board of Education proclaims that attendance matters to our school students. We are committed to focusing on reducing chronic absenteeism to give all our school children an equitable opportunity to learn, grow and thrive academically, emotionally and socially. Let's work together to get students to school on time every day.
