1. CURRICULUM, INSTRUCTION, PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, ASSESSMENT & ACCOUNTABILITY

a. Resolution for Teaching Strategies, LLC Online Services Subscription for Preschool Services

This support for use of the Creative Curriculum and Creative Curriculum – TS Gold programs will ensure the Office of Early Childhood is able to provide quality instruction in classroom settings for all preschool children.
