RE: **DISTRICT-WIDE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT**

Since 2005, the Trenton Board of Education (TBOE) engaged in a District-wide voluntary participation with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (formerly Lead Contamination Control Act), and New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection requirements. The LCCA's intent was to identify and correct lead-in-drinking-water concerns at schools and day care facilities.

The lead-in-drinking-water quality assurance program includes development of a quality assurance plan, sampling, analysis and, where required, implementation of improvements or corrective action. The program, first implemented in 2005, continues to this day through periodic monitoring and analysis and any issues identified are expeditiously addressed. Corrective actions included replacement of plumbing components, or deactivating the supply line until the condition was effectively addressed.

Based on these efforts and analytical results, TBOE is not aware of any unattended or problematic situations relating to lead-in-drinking-water within the School District. As part of its continued efforts in this regard, the TBOE is currently engaged in another round of periodic inspections and lead-in-drinking-water testing to ensure that the quality of water throughout the School District meets and exceeds the standards.
